### **2022-2023 Projects**



These improvements include the addition of a second-floor faculty restroom, the installation of a playground for elementary and middle school students, and the implementation of a security fence to enhance safety for our entire school community, including students, staff, and families. These projects became a reality thanks to generous donations from Santa Cruz Catholic Church, The Cardinal Cup Golf Tournament, and Casino Night.


Projects	Outcome
Elementary and Middle School Playground	We've added a Gaga Ball Pit, Spiderweb Climber, Volleyball net, Basketball Hoops, and an Outdoor Classroom to establish a secure and enjoyable area for our students to utilize during recess and physical education activities.
Security Fence	The installation of the security fence has fully enclosed our campus. Both the gates and rolling gates remain securely locked throughout school hours.
2nd Floor Faculty Restroom	One of the upstairs closets has been renovated into a faculty restroom. While the closet still exists, we now have a more convenient restroom option for our teachers and staff.
Repaint	The whole first floor was repainted, and any signs of wear and tear were repaired.
Strategic Plan	The Strategic plan has been finalized, and it now serves as a comprehensive roadmap to guide us for the next five years.
Technology Improvements	Each classroom was equipped with an interactive Bluetooth projector, enabling teachers to modernize their teaching methods.
